## **BY-LAW # 001-05-2014 = OPEN AIR FIRES**

- 1. ALL OPEN AIR fires are prohibited from May 1 to October 31
- 2. It is prohibited to start an open fire in the Municipality of Clarendon without a burning permit that has been obtained from the municipality.
- 3. Burning permits may be refused if climate conditions or site of fire may not be suitable for burning.
- 4. Permits may be revoked at any time.
- 5. Out of control fires and total extinguishing costs will be charged to the owner.
- 6. Out of control fires started with or without a permit, will be subject to a fine of \$100.00 plus the total cost of extinguishing the fire.
- 7. The owner or occupant of any land on which a fire is lighted or originates shall be deemed to be the person responsible for setting such fire, and shall incur the penalties provided for such offence.
- 8. This permit does not allow you to burn anything but unprocessed wood. Not allowed i.e. furniture, appliances, carpet, shingles, tires etc...
- 9. All burning permits are numbered sequentially.

- 10. The present by-law abrogates in every respect any other previous versions dealing with the topic and will have precedence over all other previous provisions contrary to this By-Law.
- 11. This present by-law will come into force according to law.
